The European Solidarity Corps is a European Union initiative funding opportunities for young people to volunteer or work in projects in the UK or abroad.

This funding scheme enables young people aged 18 to 30 years to take social action and make a difference, while having an experience that enriches their lives.

With the European Solidarity Corps, UK organisations have a great opportunity to improve provision and bring positive impact. Organisations of all types are able to apply.

There are two strands of funding: **volunteering** and **occupational**, with three funding application deadlines per year from 2019. All projects should address solidarity-related topics such as:

- Inclusion
- Citizenship and democratic participation
- Disaster prevention and recovery
- Environment and natural protection
- Health and wellbeing
- Education and training
- Reception and integration of refugees and migrants
