

ADULT EDUCATION ORGANISATIONS

Adult education staff can access mobility funding for career development or to cultivate best practices and shared resources.

HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS (HEIs)

HEIs can access funding support for activities such as innovative collaborations, international study, traineeships and staff development.

SCHOOLS

Funding can raise pupils' learning outcomes and expand their horizons and enhance teachers' professional and leadership skills.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET)

Erasmus+ for VET enables learners and staff to pursue stimulating opportunities, gaining valuable life-skills and international experience.

YOUTH

Funding can be used to organise exchanges and conferences for young people and training for youth workers.

ABOUT ERASMUS+

Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training, youth and sport. It runs until 2020 with organisations invited to apply for funding each year to undertake life-changing and worthwhile training and youth work across Europe. Erasmus+ is open to organisations across all sectors of lifelong learning.

THE UK NATIONAL AGENCY

The UK National Agency for Erasmus+ is a partnership between the British Council and Ecorys UK that manages the delivery of Erasmus+ in the UK including promoting the programme, offering advice to applicants, managing the assessment and selection of applications, and providing support to funded beneficiaries.
