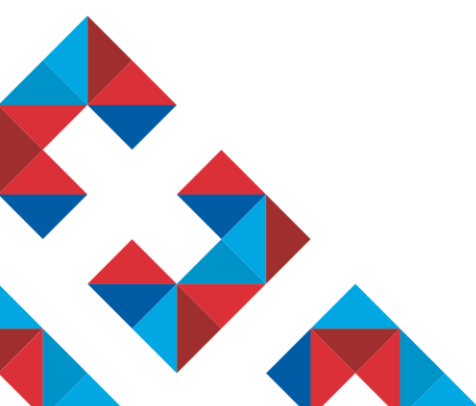

<b>EaP Windows Ukraine</b>	Ukraine	€ 100,000	No rule for incoming vs outgoing mobility
<b>Junker North Africa Window Windows</b>	Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia	€ 100,000	No rule for incoming vs outgoing mobility

In addition to the rules listed in the table above, the attainment of geographical balance is a general rule for all multi-country envelopes.
