

West Africa envelope	Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Chad, Cote D'Ivoire, The Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Senegal	€ 120,000	This budget envelope is for incoming mobilities including student study and traineeships, staff teaching and training. The only outgoing mobility which is eligible is for staff mobility for training and teaching. This funding is additional to the funding that is already available for Sub-Saharan Africa under the European Development Fund (EDF). However, HEIs will not be able to combine the funding within the same project. You will have to opt for either EDF or West Africa Trust Fund budget when funding a project with Nigeria for instance.
EDF & DCI Outgoing mobility (UK NA budget envelope)	To EDF and DCI countries at cycles 1 and 2 (all countries in the DCI and EDF regions are eligible destinations)	€ 661,809.60	This budget envelope is reserved for outgoing students enrolled in short cycle (e.g. Foundation degrees or HND courses), cycle 1 (Bachelor's) or cycle 2 (Master's) degrees.




In addition to the rules listed in the table above, the attainment of geographical balance is a general rule for all multi-country envelopes.
